

## WORKING WITH CADETS

### Special Criteria:

- \* Pioneers should be working as a leader in the Cadet Unit, on a weekly basis, for a minimum of one semester.
- \* Pioneers must have completed the Preliminary Leadership Training Course and one other advanced course.
- \* This complete Achievement may only be counted for either **RED** or **GOLD** Triangle.
- \* Programming to be done in consultation with Captain or Cadet Leader.
- \* Times given are only minimum, extra hours done by the girls should be counted as usual.
- \* Sections of this Achievement may be counted as additional hours in other triangles.
- \* A **reasonable** amount of planning/preparation time may also be included in total hours ie no more than equal to presentation time.
- \* This Achievement must be completed **in its own right** and cannot be counted towards practical work for Pioneer Leadership Training.

<p>Choose one Educational achievement, lead at least four different activities that teach the topic/s chosen in each Syllabus area(4 x 30 minutes sessions on each topic ie minimum 2 hours)</p> <p><b>AND</b></p> <p>Choose one Physical achievement, lead at least four different activities that teach the topic/s chosen in each Syllabus area (4 x 30 minutes sessions on each topic ie minimum 2 hours)</p> <p><b>AND</b></p> <p>Choose either one other Educational or Physical achievement, lead at least two different activities that teach the topic/s chosen in each Syllabus area (2x 30 minutes sessions on each topic ie minimum 1 hour)</p>	<p>Choose one Social achievement, lead at least four different activities that teach the topic/s chosen in each Syllabus area (4x 30 minutes sessions on each topic ie minimum 2 Hours)</p> <p><b>PLUS</b> at least two (2) of the following: (Minimum of 3 hours total)</p> <p>a) Arrange and take the Cadets on an outing b) Lead the Cadets in craft activities unrelated to Achievement work ie Mother's Day, Father's Day, Easter and/or Christmas. c) Teach the Cadets to perform an item at a Church Parade, Parent's Night, Aged People's Complex etc d) Take Cadets for games at a Divisional/State function.</p>	<p>Using the Achievements taught in Skills and Service lead at least four Devotions using different activities (4 x 15 minutes ie minimum of 1 hour)</p> <p><b>AND/OR</b></p> <p>Take the Cadets for Devotions (minimum 4 x 15 minutes sessions ie 1 hour)</p> <p><b>AND/OR</b></p> <p>Take devotions at a Cadet Sleepover including a story and activity (Minimum 1 hour)</p> <p>Extra Spiritual hours may be taken from other Achievements if needed, to complete 5 hours.</p>
