Evening ladies

***The Girls' Brigade has been asked to participate in the Brisbane City ANZAC March for 2010.*** We are positioned at number 143 and therefore will march as a complete unit in full uniform (including stockings) at approximately 11.50am. Once you have participated in your local community marches, travel free on public transport and assemble on the William Street side of Queens Park in between the casino and hotel no later than **11am**. Junior Girls can march at the discretion of the Company Captain and would boost our numbers immensely.

About 15 minutes before the Girls and Leaders march, all who are marching will be formed into ranks to 'march on' the Colours and to determine the lines for marching on the city streets. The Colours will be required to 'march off' at the end so please follow the drill commands at the end of the march. If you have girls who would like to be part of the colour party, please let Kirsty Levis, Glenda Brooks or the office know by **9<sup>th</sup> April 2009**.

As we will be waiting as a unit before we march, it would be great to bring extra people with you who could carry your food, drink and extra belongings. A black bag looks professional with our uniform if you are required to carry personal belongings.

As veterans of units are no longer able to march their banners are flown at the beginning of the parade. The Girls' Brigade has been nominated to carry these banners so 20 Seniors, Pioneers and Leaders are essential to march at 10am. If you are able to assist please let Kirsty Levis, Glenda Brooks or the office know by **9<sup>th</sup> April 2010**.

Guides Queensland with Boys' Brigade and Girls' Brigade will carry numbered paddles (approximately 120) throughout the march. A separate tent will be in Queens Park for 'Youth' where banners and numbered paddles will be allocated from **9.30am**. Full uniform will be requested with minimal luggage. Those carrying banners will be signed out by unit leaders. Youth carrying numbered paddles will be slotted in with the Marshal groups at the beginning of the parade, about the corner of George and Elizabeth Streets. Maps and directions are to be provided at the end of the March in Queen Street, so the youth organisations are able to return to Queens Park in time to march as a whole unit.
